We raised a grand total of £187.93. Let's hope our next one is just as successful!

# What has the money been used for?

With all of the events you've attended and money raised you might be wondering "where has it gone?" Well, we haven't hung around and have put it straight to good use!

We have put money towards new books for the children at Christmas time and a portable PA system (which was great at all of those noisy Christmas parties!).

£1000 was donated towards the EYFS outdoor area, a project which will see great improvements for the reception classes who use the area as an outdoor classroom as well as a place to play and have fun.

The money that was raised from the Class 1 and 2 bake sales was also put towards this project to buy smaller items to decorate and for the children to play with.

Alongside all of this we have also funded the coaches (£900) to take the children to the pantomime and made a £600 donation to the college where the performance is held. Also each child had some treats to enjoy while they watched which came to £63.14.

#### **Bake Sales**

The Class 1 and 2 bake sales were a brilliant success together raising a grand total of £194.10.

Every class will get a turn to run a bake sale so we will be looking for parents and family members to help out and/or donate some sweet treats.

We will ensure we give plenty of notice of the time and date.
